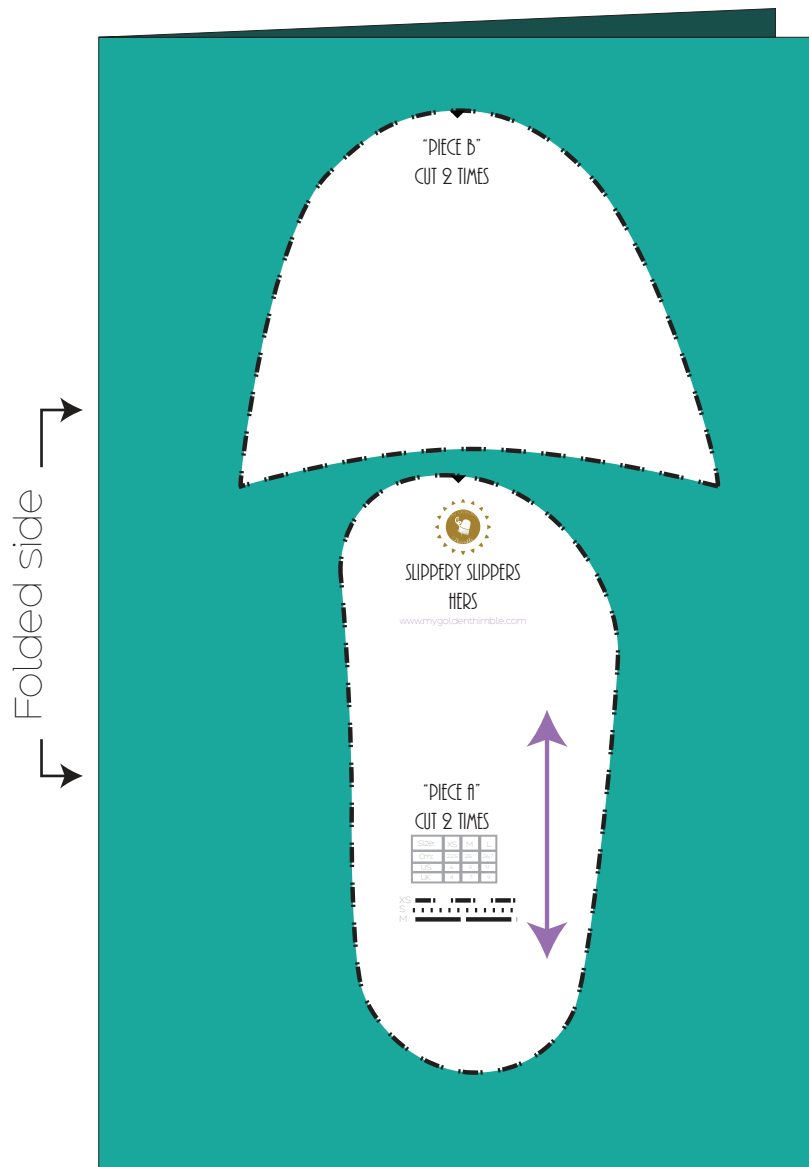
Cheat Sheet

Symbols:	
	Grain line: Indicates the cross-wise grain of the fabric runs in the direction of the arrow.
	Fold fabric: Indicates where to fold an even piece of fabric so you can cut the complete piece of the pattern in mirror.
	Join the pages: Join the circles with the same number 1 with 1, 2 with 2, and so on...
	Join the piece: Form the diamond taping the pieces together. This symbol is used in large pieces.

Symbols:	
	Cut line: Cut along the dotted line to get your pattern pieces.
	Fold fabric piece: Indicates where the end product folds.
	Point of reference: Use this point to mark in the fabric usefull points of references.
	Notch: Cut a little triangle to match one piece with the other piece of the project that has the same notch.
